Program

The Department of Educational Leadership has been offering two-year M Ed in Leadership and Management. The graduates of this program are expected to be responsive to the changing educational technologies, pedagogical practices, and innovation in education. They are expected to be leaders, strategic thinkers, trainers, researchers, entrepreneurs, curriculum designers and material developers for educational organizations. Moreover, the program is designed to prepare educational professionals to be the key advocates for transforming society through their leadership and managerial roles.

Structure of the program

This 24 credit program is divided into four semesters. There are two core courses of 6 credits, 11 specialization courses of 33 credits, two elective courses of 6 credits and three practical courses of 9 credits.

Entry requirements

For enrolment in two-year M Ed in Leadership and Management program, the candidate must have a Bachelor's degree in any discipline (B. Ed/BA/B. Sc) or any equivalent degree recognized by Kathmandu University with second division or CGPA 2.5 out of 4 in aggregate.

Program

Structure of the program

This is a one-year Master's degree program of 27 credit hours. This program also follows the semester system, and thus the courses will be offered in two semesters.

Candidates having a master's degree in any discipline and a recognized teaching qualification at the basic or secondary level will be eligible for applying to this program.

M Ed in Early Childhood Development 1 Year

Program

The Department of Educational Leadership offers programs in interdisciplinary areas with a special focus on teacher education to develop human resources required for nation building with special reference to education and pedagogy. The purpose of this one-year M Ed in Early Childhood Development Program at Kathmandu University is to prepare professionals (leaders and teachers, educators, entrepreneurs, and trainers) to fulfill the need of the experts in early childhood development in the country.

Structure of the program

This is a two-semester program comprising 9 courses of 3-credits each, i.e. 27 credits in total. The program consists of:

- a. Two Core Courses (6-credits)
- b. Five Professional Courses (15-credits)
- c. Two Practical Courses (6-credits).

Entry requirements

The candidates having a Master's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or an institution recognized by Kathmandu University are eligible to apply for the program.

Post-Graduate Diploma in Educational Management 1 Year

Program

The purpose of the Post-Graduate Diploma in Educational Management (PGDEM) program at Kathmandu University (KU) is to produce competent educational professionals for the overall management of school system. Structure of the program

The 27 credit hour program includes (a) core course (b) specialization courses, and (c) practicum. Core courses provide basic skills for understanding the teaching learning process and the role of education in society.

The entry requirement for the Post-Graduate Diploma in Educational Management will be a bachelor's degree from any discipline.
